## Two tickets will be given out each day:

---

- Banner rules:
  1. Banner paper will be provided and will be 5 foot long, 2 foot wide.
  2. All banners will have a Colts Basketball theme.
- Decoration competition rules:
  1. You can only decorate the Bulletin Board (Elementary).
  2. Only students can create Bulletin Boards, Run through Sports Banner and mini floats. NO parents or teachers involved - teacher supervision only (except for elementary classes).
  3. Theme for the decorations is "Colts at the Circus."
- Overall Spirit Week winning class from:
  - Elementary will have a movie afternoon.
  - Middle School will have a free half day in school.
  - High School will win a half day off school campus.
