Report Cards Going Digital (E-mail/RenWeb)

Third quarter report cards will be sent out today. For Upper School students, we have moved away from the customary paper kind and gone digital! Upper School families will now receive report cards through e-mail and RenWeb. This method will eliminate the student having to bring home a paper report card to be signed and returned. It will also place the grades more quickly in the hands of the parents. This change is in place for the Upper School beginning immediately, and will go into effect for Lower School for the 2013-2014 school years. CCS Open House Next Week - New Student Referral Discount

The **CCS Open House** is taking place next week, March 18 - 22 from 9:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m. daily to walk prospective families through the building and to answer any questions. The Open House is a great opportunity for our current families to refer new families to visit the school. Please be reminded that CCS is offering a **New Student Referral Discount** for current families. Parents/Guardians may discount their tuition payments by aiding the school in enrolling new students (other than their own children). A current family that refers a new student will earn a \$500 tuition credit for each new student enrolled when that new student indicates on the enrollment application that he/she heard about the school through that family. The only limits to this discount are that it cannot exceed the cost of a family's annual tuition and that it cannot be carried over to the next school year.

Missing Work Due to Illness and Planned Absences

With the increasing number of students being out of school due to illness, it was important for CCS to set policies for how missing work would be handled. Please carefully read the information below to familiarize yourself with these new policies.

Planned Absences

CCS understands that students may miss days during the year due to family vacations, mission trips, etc. CCS requests that you inform the school of the planned absence at least one week in advance. While the CCS faculty will not be able to give a complete list of work to be made-up prior to a planned absence, the students should take their textbooks with them and check RenWeb for a list of daily assignments missed.



Absences for Illness

Absent 1 Day: If a student misses one day of school, that student will see his/her teacher(s) the following day to obtain a list of all work missed on the day of absence. Parents will be able to come by the school to pick up student textbooks if they desire, but a detailed listing of everything missed will not be available until the following day, and that list will be given to the student.

Absent 2+ Days: If a student misses two or more days, the parent can contact teacher(s) or the school office to request all missing work for the days missed or that will be missed. The teacher will have all missing work available for the parents to pick up between 3:20 p.m. and 4:00 p.m. Lower School students will be able to pick up their textbooks from the office, and Upper School parents will be able to go to their child's locker to obtain textbooks. Please check RenWeb for missing assignment information.
