CCS Families,

The annual Fall Festival and Craft Show is tomorrow, October 30, from 3:30 p.m. until 6:30 p.m. It will take place in the back parking lot of CCS, and we will be using the cafeteria and gym areas as well. With set-up beginning for the event Friday morning, I wanted to let everyone know information regarding carpool tomorrow. With the event taking place at the back of the school, we will have normal drop-off tomorrow morning. Students who drive to school will be able to park in the front as normal.

Lower and upper school pick-up will run as normal at the front of the school. We will run carpool until 3:15, and at that time all students who are left will be sent to aftercare. The only change to pick-up will be that students who ride a bus home will load the busses behind the school near the softball field (lower school students will be walked to the busses as normal).

If you are planning to attend the Fall Festival with your child(ren), you may park in the front lot or in the field to the left of the school road and walk in to pick up your child. We would greatly appreciate you picking them up prior to 3:15 and waiting a few minutes for the event to begin. Under no circumstance are lower school students allowed to stay for the Fall Festival without parent/adult supervision. School staff will have other responsibilities during the event and will not be able to supervise individual students.

The event will include a craft show, along with the following items for the children: four inflatables (castle with slide bounce house, obstacle course, 22-foot large slide, and a monster truck bounce house for children 5 and under), a cake-walk, numerous games, hay rides, and tons of food (hot dogs, hamburgers, cotton candy, homemade ice cream, onion rings, funnel cakes, etc.).

One event that I wanted to make sure everyone knows about is the pie-in-the-face booth! This year, we have numerous CCS faculty members, including myself, who will be participating. I wanted to give everyone a heads-up of the faculty members who will be participating and the times they will be in the booth. The cost for throwing a whip cream pie at them is only a dollar from a short distance, or you can pay a few dollars more and get up real close! Check the list carefully and mark down the times that you want to come and throw a pie!
