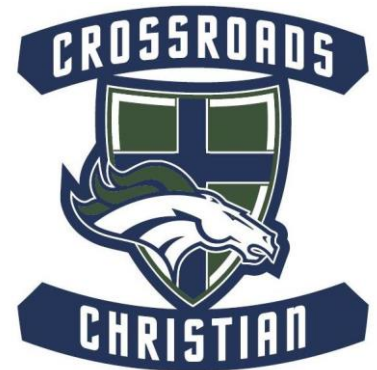

## CCS Announces New Athletic Director & Varsity Men's Basketball Coach

CCS is proud to announce that Mr. Scottie Richardson has been hired as our new athletic director and varsity men's basketball coach, effective June 1, 2018. Mr. Richardson succeeds Mr. Jamie Parker as athletic director. Mr. Parker has served as A.D. since 2016. He met with administration in October of 2017 to let them know that his desire was to be back in the classroom full-time beginning with the 2018-2019 school year, and that he would be stepping down from his role as A.D. effective May 31, 2018. Mr. Parker is a valuable part of the CCS family and has served as A.D. faithfully with his sole desire to make a difference in the lives of our students. We are grateful for all that Mr. Parker has done, and we are blessed to have him continue his role of teacher at Crossroads.

Mr. Richardson brings 23 years of successful coaching (high school and college) and leadership experience to CCS. His teams have won multiple championships at the national, state, and conference levels, including state titles in men's basketball, women's volleyball, men's soccer, and golf. He most recently served at Neuse Christian in Raleigh, NC, where he built their athletic program to state prominence in all sports. His understanding and ability to work with athletes, coaches, and parents led to his selection as the new athletic director. CCS was seeking a leader of integrity who would champion our athletics program while putting emphasis on the whole child, as we want our students to grow spiritually, academically, and physically, and we found that in Mr. Richardson. Mr. Richardson is a hard-working educator who brings a passion with him, and he will be a wonderful addition to the CCS family.



The JV and Varsity basketball players were introduced to their new coach earlier today, and a meeting will be scheduled over the next few weeks for parents and students to come meet our new athletic director and hear about his passion and plans for CCS athletics.
