All middle school students will take final exams, with the exception of middle school students in high school courses (Algebra I) who meet the exemption criteria. Exams are an important part of upper school. We believe it will benefit students to become familiar with the process of taking an exam before they reach high school. May 16-17 will be set aside as exam review days, and students will be given a study guide for each exam. Exam week schedules for each grade level are listed below. **Please note that school is dismissed at 12:00 on exam days.**


