Yesterday, the Governor of North Carolina made an executive order that all North Carolina public schools close for the next two weeks, and that there should be no gatherings of 100 or more people. It is perfectly understandable for our school families to have varying opinions regarding appropriate responses to the Coronavirus, especially in regard to whether the school should close or not. Decisions regarding Crossroads have been made through prayer and based on current information from the CDC and health department. Our goal has been to remain open and serve our school community as long as we could, but following the Governor's executive order, CCS will follow his directive and close school for two weeks. This closure does include our daycare.

As was stated in an earlier information, CCS has enough built-in hours to accommodate the closure of school from March 16-20, and spring break will remain March 23-27. In preparation for the scenario where school is closed longer than two weeks, CCS staff will have workdays this coming week to plan for remote education. To ensure that students have all the items they need should remote education be required, families can pick-up school and personal belongings on Wednesday, March 18 from 1:00 PM to 4:00 PM or Thursday, March 19 from 9:00 AM to 3:00 PM. Outside of the times just listed, Crossroads campus will be closed to students, parents and visitors.

We know that this is a challenging time, and it will take the entire CCS family working together to navigate through this situation, as we strive to protect the health and well-being of our students. Our deepest thanks in advance for continuing to partner with us during this extraordinary time. We ask that you continue to pray for our school community and those that lead our state and nation.
