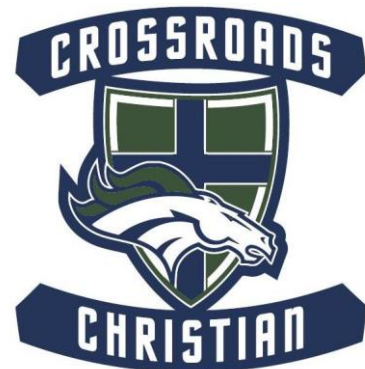

Re-enrollment Ending Soon!

Re-enrollment for the 2019-2020 school year at the discounted rate will end next Wednesday, February 20. Families can re-enroll during this time for only \$150 per child, a \$100 discount per child. **The enrollment fee becomes \$250 on Thursday, February 21.** To start your re-enrollment process, log in to your existing RenWeb account and click on the Apply/Enroll link on the left.

- **Marie O'Donoghue - 9th grade** 1st place overall in Soft Pastel (for grades 9-12)

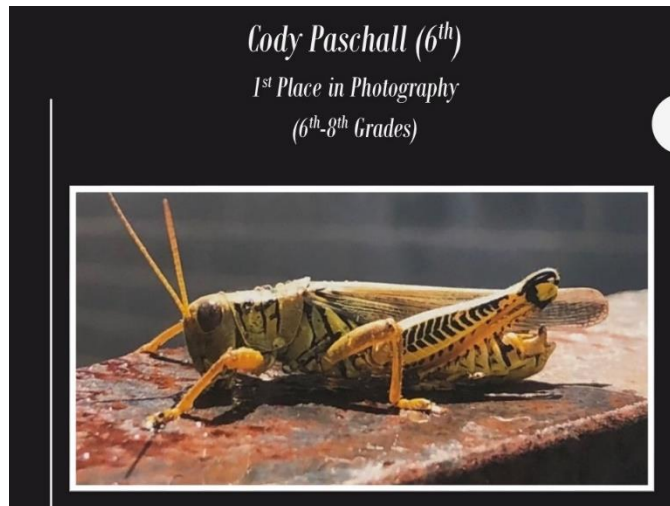
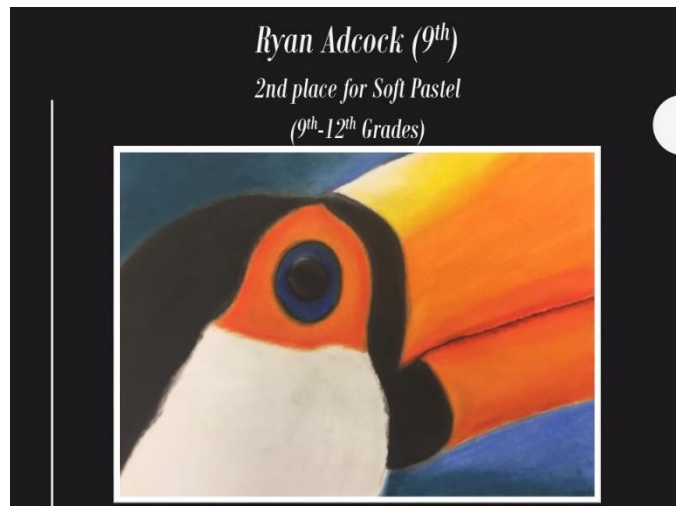
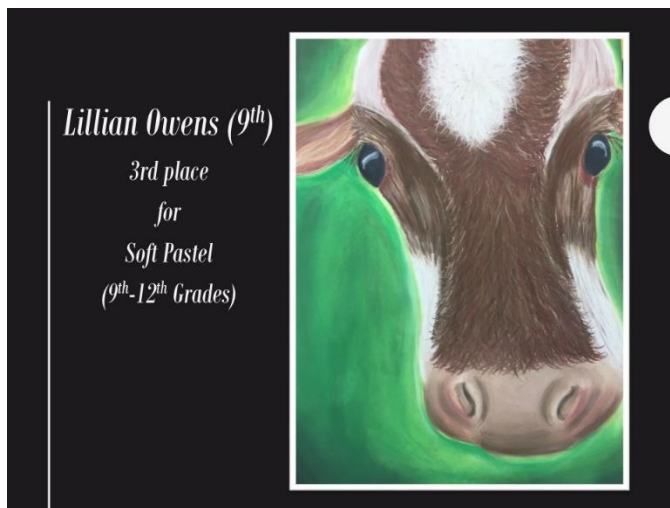
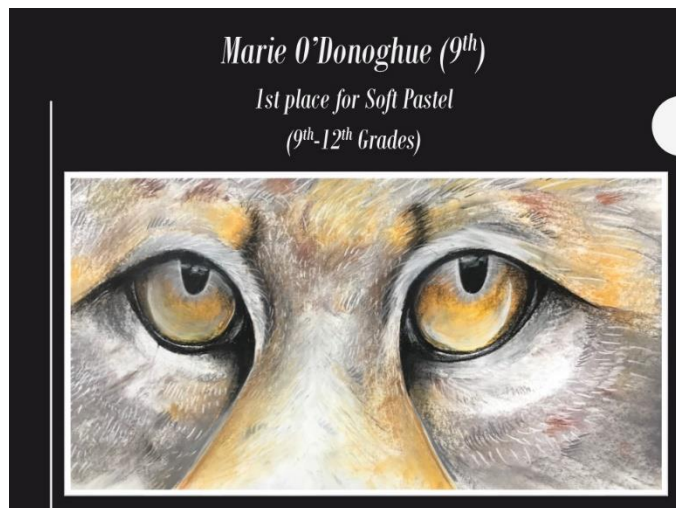
Other CCS students that competed and placed well for their age and category were the following:

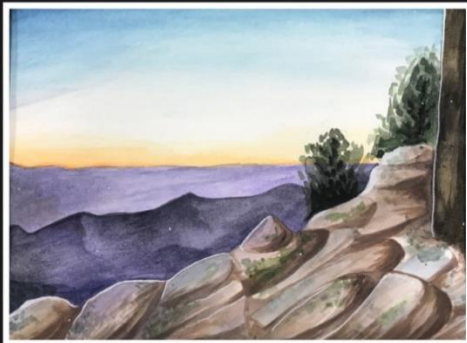
