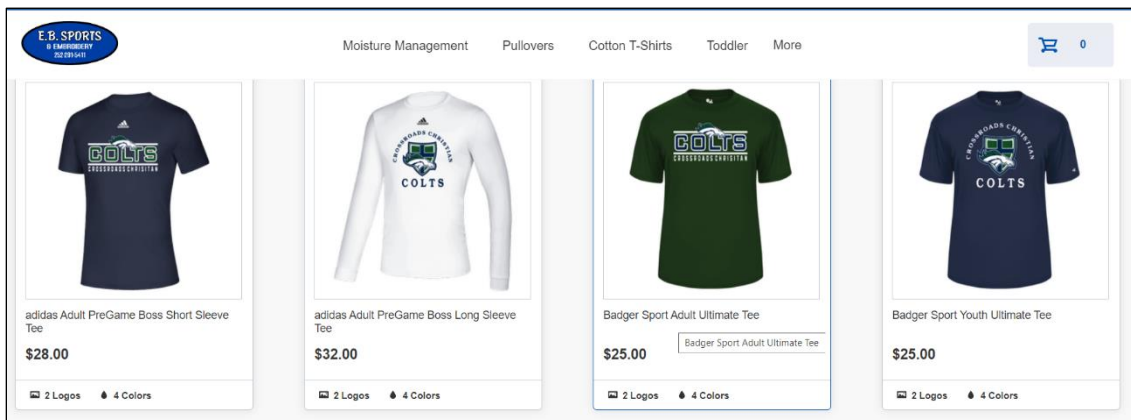

Parents/guardians can pick up their summer camp packets and make payments at Open House.

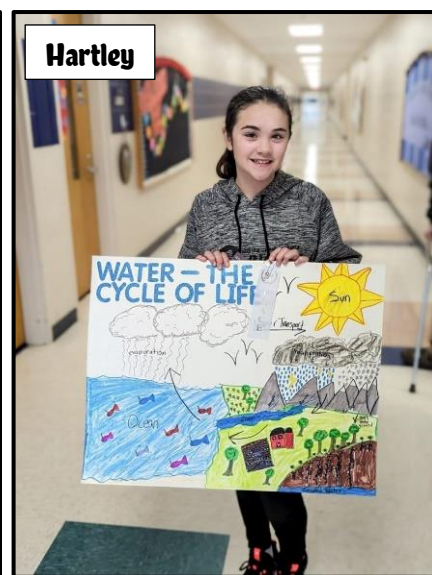

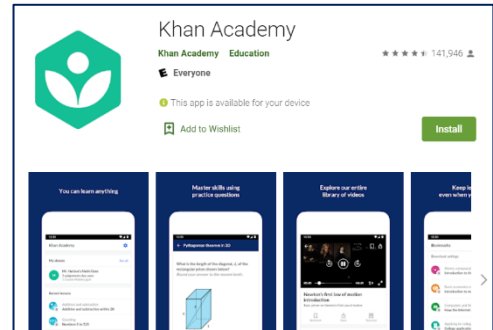

Art Festival – Friday, April 14

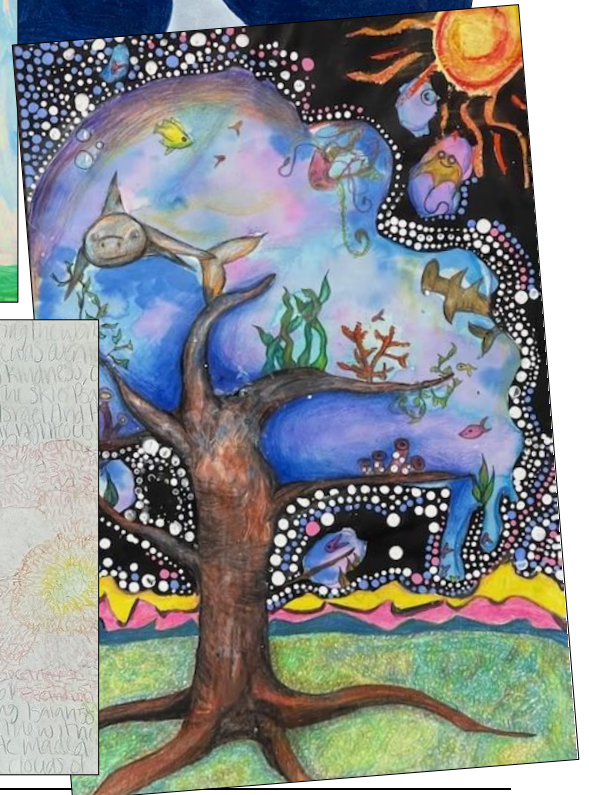
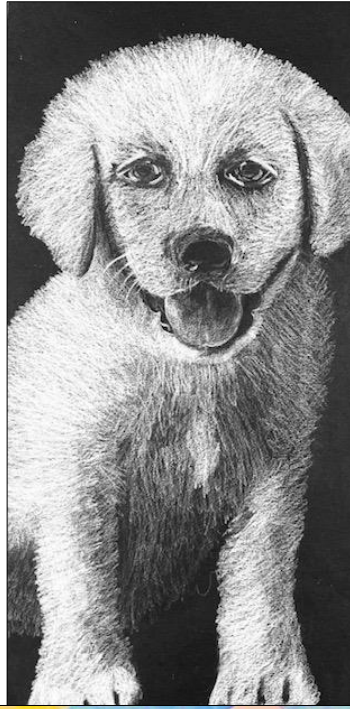

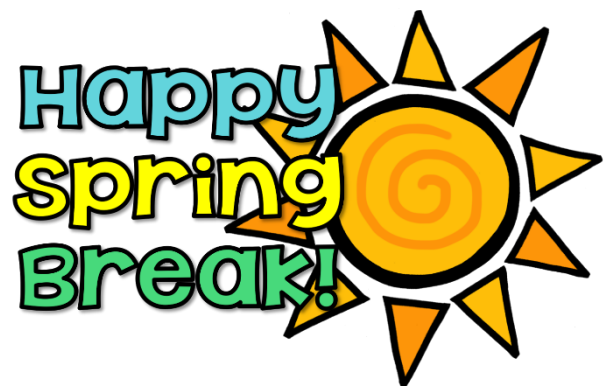
