## Computer News from Mrs. Jones

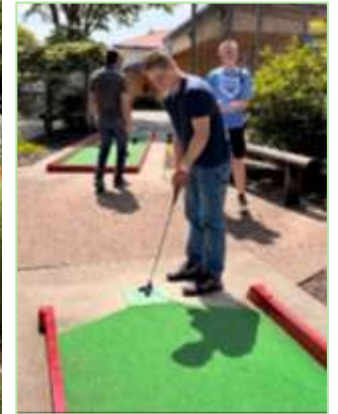
