This year's theme is "Big World Recess" and is focused on building character through sports. Students will travel around our big world and learn positive character traits from kids in other cultures.

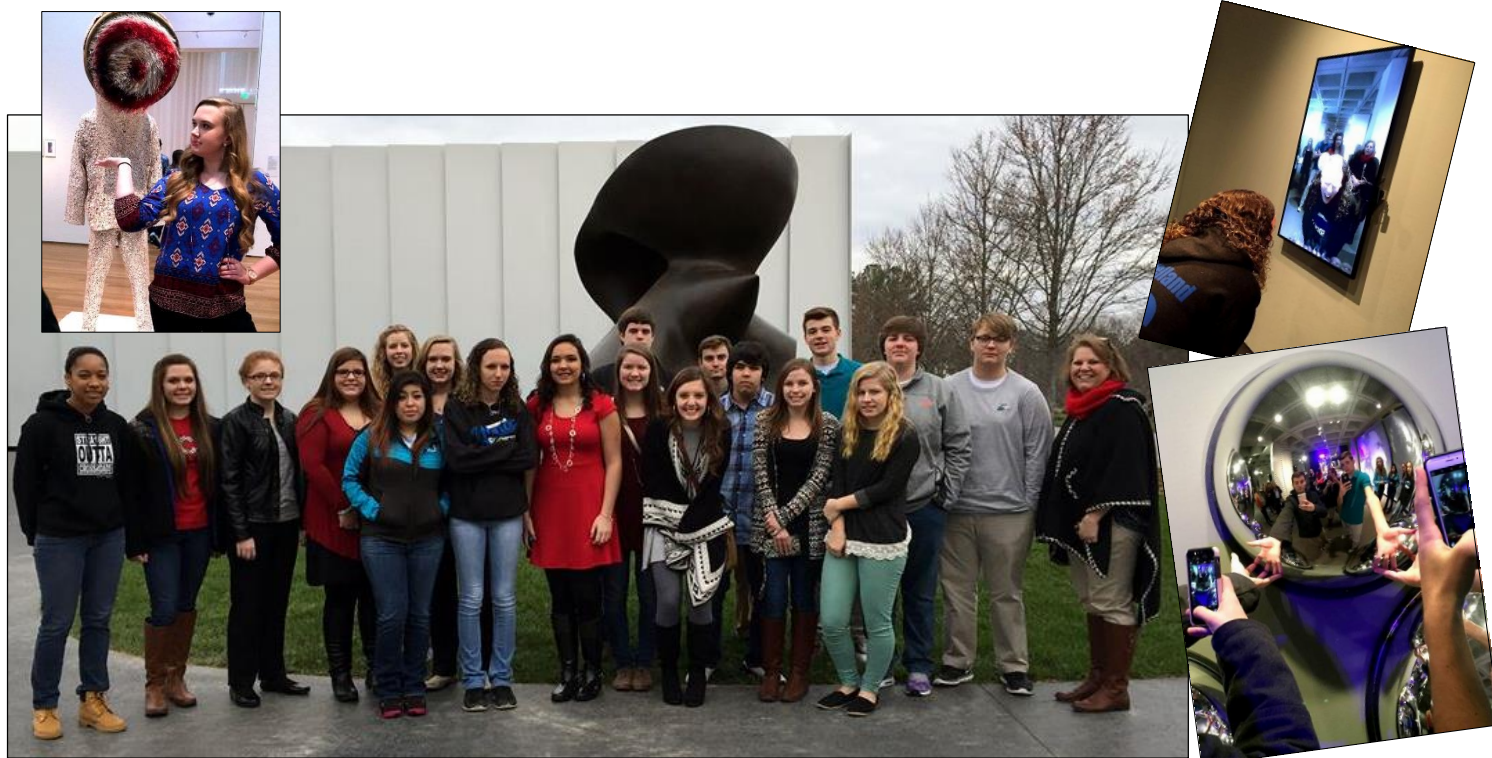
The lower school students will take part in the typical run, while the upper school students will be able to participate in a color run.
