One Week Until Re-enrollment Opens!

Re-enrollment for the 2017-2018 school year will begin on Monday, February 6, with a two-week window to re-enroll at a discounted rate. During the December board meeting, the CCS school board approved to *not* increase tuition for next school year, with fees also staying the same. CCS is also lowering the re-enrollment fee for those families who re-enroll during the re-enrollment period. From Monday, February 6, through Saturday, February 18, families can re-enroll for only \$150 per child, a \$100 discount per child. The enrollment fee becomes \$250 on Sunday, February 19.

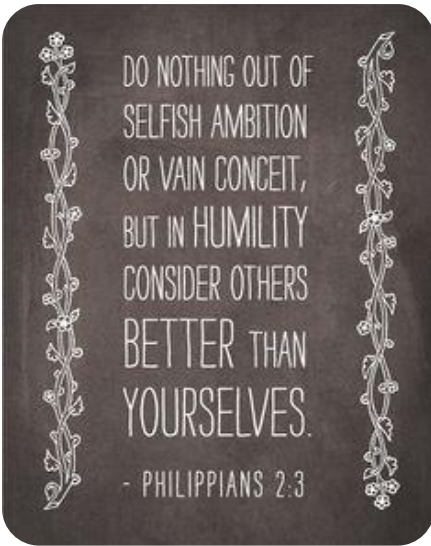
We are thankful for all of our CCS families, and we look forward to continuing our partnership with you as we train our young men and women to serve Christ and to be leaders with a Christian worldview.
