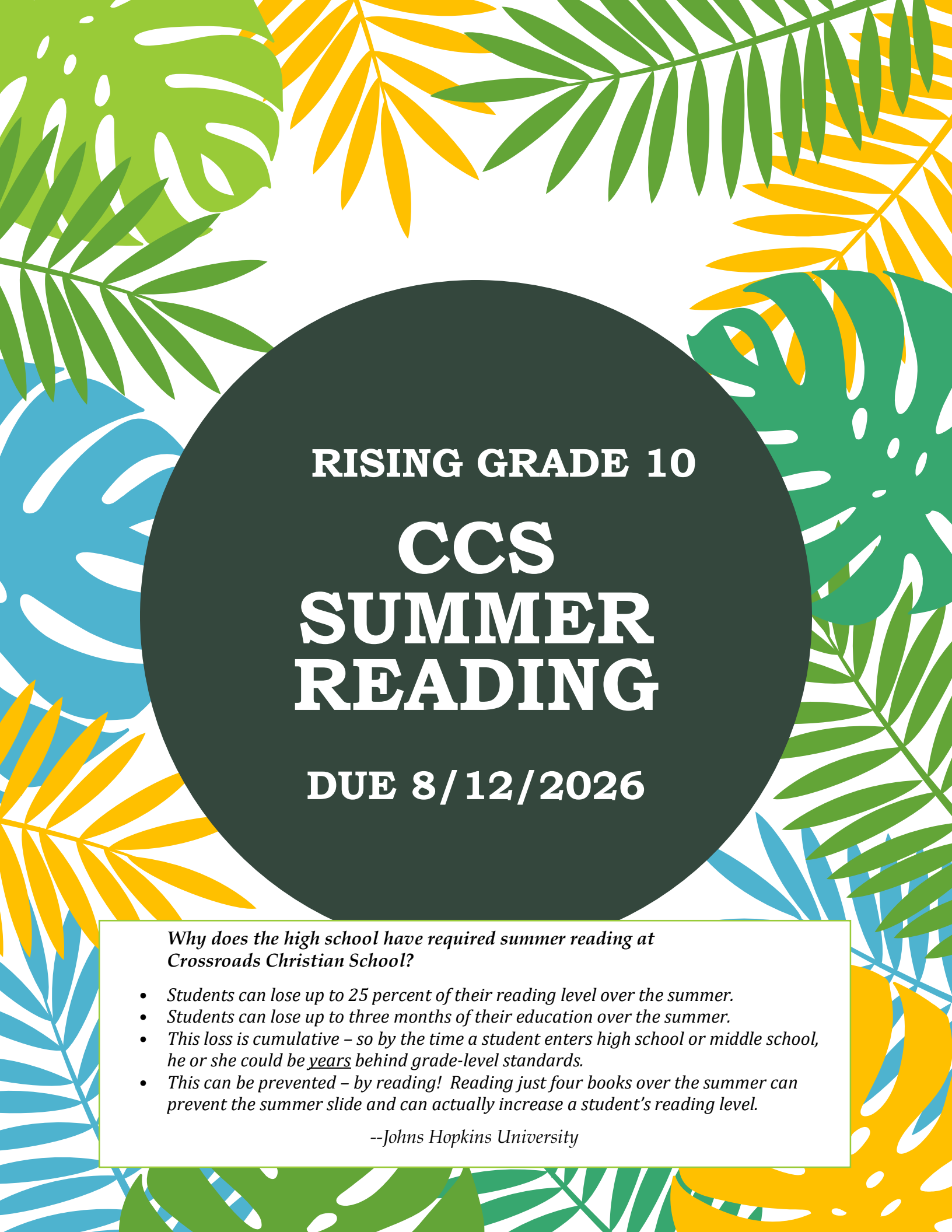

Why does the high school have required summer reading at Crossroads Christian School?

- *Students can lose up to 25 percent of their reading level over the summer.*
- *Students can lose up to three months of their education over the summer.*
- *This loss is cumulative – so by the time a student enters high school or middle school, he or she could be years behind grade-level standards.*
- *This can be prevented – by reading! Reading just four books over the summer can prevent the summer slide and can actually increase a student's reading level.*

- Standard grammatical conventions (proper spelling, proper capitalization, etc) are expected. Your review will be graded accordingly.
- You may elect to read an additional book from the list below and complete a review for extra credit. You will need to contact me for a link to an extra credit review.
- The assignment should be completed on a desktop or laptop. The application is not mobile-friendly and may not work properly on a mobile device. This includes tablets running a mobile OS as well as smartphones.
